When Planted by Forever Green Landscape

All evergreens, deciduous trees and shrubs are guaranteed 100% for the first year (365 days) from the date of purchase. Each 100% credit must be applied to one item of nursery stock selling at the same or higher retail unit price as the original purchase. Adjustments will be made on nursery stock and nursery stock only. No cash refund will be made. Roses, rhododendrons, azaleas, groundcovers, annuals, perennials, bulbs, sod, seed and sale or discounted merchandise bear no guarantee written, verbal or implied. All returned merchandise must be accompanied with a sale slip and in good condition. Replacements bear no guarantee and will only be made one time against original merchandise.

Each 50% credit must be applied to one item of nursery stock selling at the same or higher retail unit price as the original purchase. Adjustments will be made on nursery stock and nursery stock only. No cash refund will be made. Roses, rhododendrons, azaleas, groundcovers, annuals, perennials, bulbs, sod, seed and sale or discounted merchandise bear no guarantee written, verbal or implied. All returned merchandise must be accompanied with a sale slip and in good condition. Replacements bear no guarantee and will only be made one time against original merchandise.

WARRANTY IS VOID UPON REMOVAL OF WIRE BASKET AND/OR BURLAP SACK ON ANY BALL & BURLAP TREE OR SHRUB.

WARRANTY

For Trees On Sale

Please note: The following warranty applies only to trees that are on sale. Shrubs and perennials that are on sale are NOT covered by this warranty.

The tree will have a one-year warranty from the date of purchase. If the tree should die within a 365-day period, Forever Green Landscape Center will replace it with a new tree of the same type and size. The purchaser will be responsible for paying the difference between the sale price and the new full retail price.

HELPFUL TIPS

for Trees & Shrubs



- Use root stimulator to begin assisting roots in immediate growth after planting.
- Fertilize hydrangeas at least twice a month.
- Throughout all growing seasons, consider constant pruning of dead branches or out bloomed flowers.
- If leaves on plants look eaten or have spots, look into using a general insecticide or fungicide
- Pay attention to conditions, i.e. light, moisture, soil type, etc. where you plan to plant trees or shrubs to increase likelihood of survival.
- The use of "Wilt Stop" or "Wilt Pruf" can help reduce windburn, sunscald, winter dieback, death, transplant shock and salt damage.

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR CLAY SOIL:

All holes should be 1 ½ - 2 times the width of the ball. Plant the tree with about 1-2" of the root ball above the existing grade. The ground under the root ball should remain undisturbed.

FOR SANDY SOIL:

All holes should be 1 ½ - 2 times the width of the ball and the depth should be level with the existing grade.

BACKFILL WITH TOPSOIL and mound over the tree with 1" of topsoil, then mulch over the top of the ball of the tree. Be sure to keep the root ball covered with topsoil and mulch at all times to retain moisture in the root ball.

BE SURE TO CUT ANY ROPE AND/OR BURLAP AT THE BASE OF THE TREE TRUNK, (TOP OF BALL) DO NOT REMOVE THE WIRE BASKET OR THE BURLAP FROM THE BALL.

WATERING INSTRUCTIONS

TREES:

The tree should be watered immediately after being planted for at least one hour, longer on larger trees. Set the hose at the base of the tree and turn hose to a steady trickle. Make sure the water is soaking the ball of the tree thoroughly. After initial watering, the tree should be watered with a steady trickle approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour every five to seven days, depending on temperature and rainfall. Continue this routine through the first growing season. In subsequent years, water as needed.

SHRUBS:

Follow the same as above but adjust the time to 10 to 15 minutes per shrub depending on the size of the plant.
